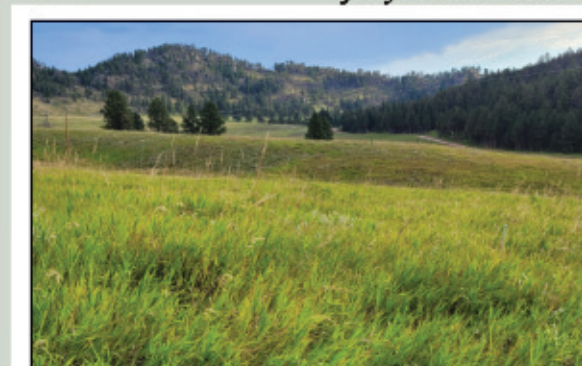

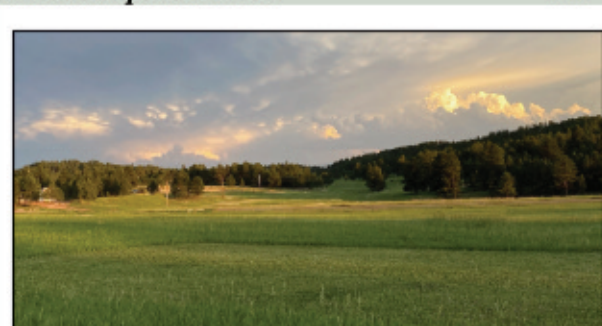

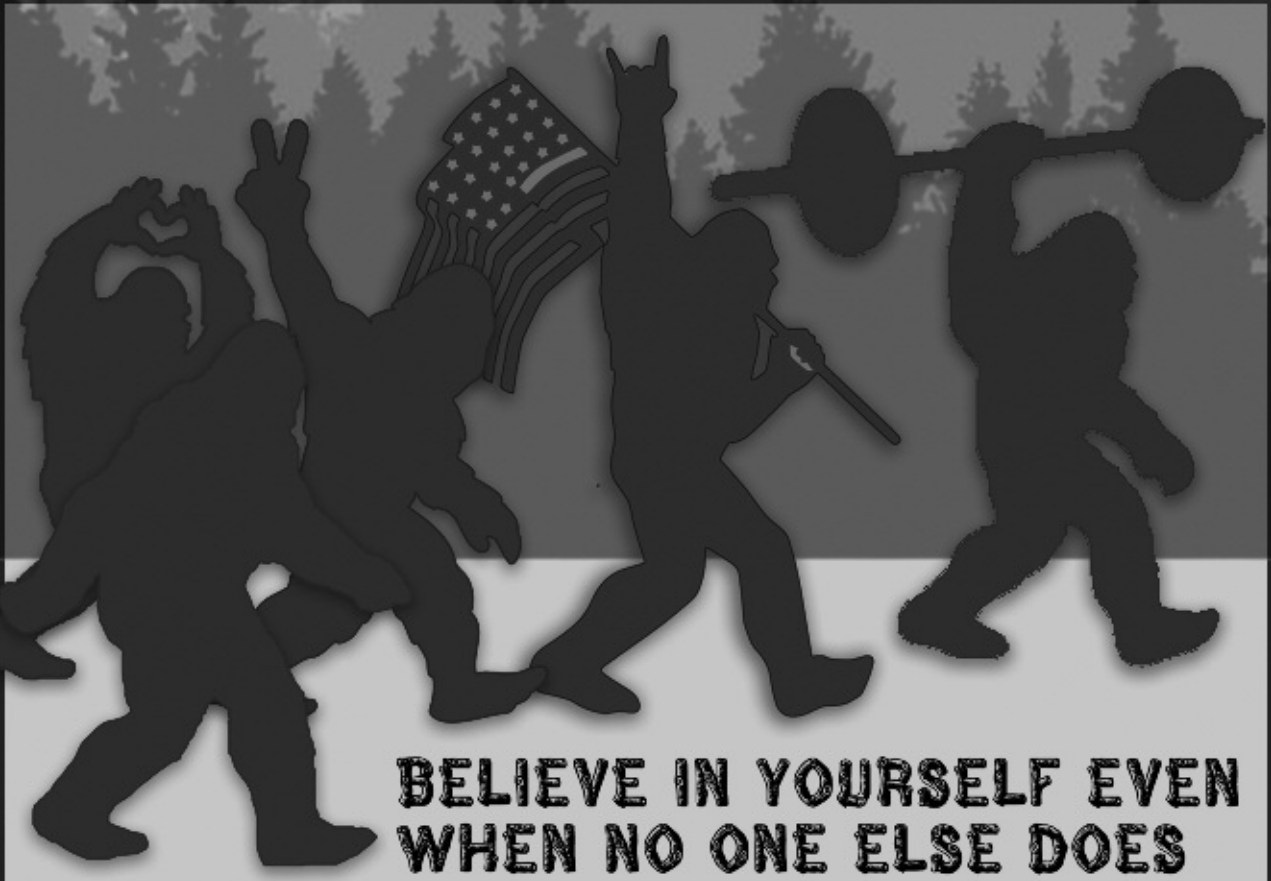

The Touch

Study after study reveals that experiencing live music invites a wealth of measurable positive effects on our brain chemistry. Sound waves, in certain configurations, can trigger endorphins that lower our stress levels, increase our creativity and cognitive function, improve our mood, reduce physical pain and create the chemical foundation for shared communal experiences.

But music is everywhere, you say! Why don't I feel serenity and relief everytime I hear 'Folsom Prison Blues' on the radio? - It's all a matter of scale and sensitivity.

Our brains like patterns, structures, & forms. We put discrete edges on things so we know where one ends and the next begins.

Imagine reading a book without paragraphs or chapter breaks, or watching an entire season of Friends without any breaks between the episodes. How exhausting! Music is

the same way, it originates from silence (or at least a baseline of ambient noise) and eventually it fades away.

Our ears (and more so the brains they're connected to) have built-in mechanisms for sorting through the noise of the world, pushing some things into the background, and pulling others forward. This is how we can understand the waiter in a noisy restaurant, or hear the sound of our spouse's unique whistle at the fairgrounds when we get separated. Our brains are constantly shoving the noise into the background so we can focus on what we believe is important.

Recorded music gets mixed into this noise soup all the time, and after a while, certain songs lose their flavor and fade further into the background.

And so I ask you, dear reader, what tugs at your ear in an age where every little beep, buzz, ding and chime is clamoring for your attention?

Strip away the compression, the auto-tune,

equalization and studio magic of recorded music. Imagine the sound of an acoustic guitar ringing out in real life, with all its woody shimmering tones. Imagine hearing someone strum a few chords in the middle of the airport. When it's live, it cuts through the noise differently, the colors of the music are more vivid.

For better or worse, live music comes and goes in a different way than the piped-in radio songs we're all too familiar with. This type of rarified sound, sculpted in real time, literally pushes the air around us in tantalizing, and irreproducible ways.

In short, whether you're listening or not, live music in particular 'touches' the body in a meaningful way, makes weird and wonderful things happen in our hearts and minds. Live music can leave you literally changed at a molecular level.

If you love live music, the science is here to show you that live music loves you back.
